### Mathematics and Numeracy

- We will be subtracting by counting back using a number line and counters.
- We will be reciting and arranging the days of the week and months of the year in the right order and singing the song.
- We will be telling the time to the hour, half hour, quarter past and quarter to on an analogue and digital clock practically, on paper and by playing games.
- We will be recognising different coins and counting different amounts of money.
- We will be learning how to make multiplication calculations practically.
- We will be learning our 2, 10, 5 and 3 times tables.
- We will be measuring small toy animals and drawing life size animals with chalk.

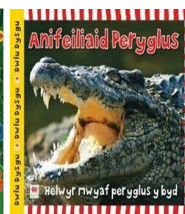
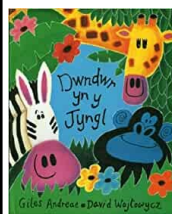
### Science and Technology

- The children will get the chance to create their own animals habitat in the forest.
- We will be learning facts about different animals habitat.
- We will be learning about the animals food chains.
- We will be labelling and comparing different animals.

### Language and Literacy

- We will be describing dangerous animals using adjectives and creating a fact file about the different animals.
- We will be listening to the story 'The tiger that came to tea' ac creating an invitation to a party / tea party.
- We will be listening to the story 'Rumble in the jungle' and creating our own rhyming poems.
- In the role play area the children will get the chance to pretend that they are in a safari / in the house having a tea party.
- We will be playing verbal games by describing and guessing animals 'Who am I?'
