Mathematics and Numeracy

- In our Mathematics lessons, we will look at multiplication, division, measurement and money.
- We will apply these skills through our exciting theme, The Fair, measuring different rides and finding their perimeters and area.
- Pupils will have the opportunity to buy goods dealing with expenditure, budget and pocket money.

Language and Literacy

- We will start the theme by using our senses to describe different rides at the fair.
- Pupils will have the opportunity to use their emotions to write a soliloquy of their experience at the fair.
- We will be acting and playing role during this half term and express an opinion by writing a formal letter about a fair coming to the town of Llanrwst.
- Pupils will have the opportunity to create an attractive invitation to the Fair using a green screen as a way of attracting guests.

Humanities

- Pupils will have the opportunity to write a formal letter to the council about the impact of a fair coming to Llanrwst. There will be discussions about the community, traffic, loss / profit, environment.
- We will be researching into adventure parks across Europe and arrange a family visit there.
- We will have a Religious Education week closer to Christmas where we will celebrate and study the Christmas of the Christian.
